1 B) KOI ENTRY



* Entry is based on HONOUR system. The participant is to self declare all information correctly, particularly to ensure that the size of the Koi shall be correct at the time of benching or judging. Any Koi found to be over the size limit shall be disqualified and shall not be entitled to any prize.

Participants shall participate in the spirit of good sportsmanship and to respect the decision of the Judges and show committee. In the event of any dispute in the results, a participant may lodge his complaint with the Show Committee with a **Lodgement fee of RM500**. The Show Committee may at its discretion accept the complaint and if accepted, the complaint shall be presented to the Show Chairman and Head Judge for review. **If the complaint is successful, the fee shall be returned.** In all cases, the Show Chairman shall be the sole authority for the Interpretation of Rules and Regulations and The judge's decision is final.

The participant have read and understood the Rules & Regulations of the Competition and shall abide by them and agree to indemnify the show committee and Kelab Ikan Koi ZNA Malaysia, Kuala Lumpur against any incidences, loss, damage or death of their Koi at the show site.

(i) IN PVC BAG – 25BU ~ 50BU. IN & OUT on same day

Kois are entered and judged in official PVC bags provided from the club. Kois photos and registration forms must be submitted **ON-LINE** by **Thurs, 16th**. Kois shall be benched and de-benched on Saturday (*see item 7*) after completion of judging or to owner's tank.

Holding tanks can be provided (on 1st come 1st served basis) for **OUTSTATION** entries of 6 kois and above for this size categories. *If available, holding tanks for those less than 6 kois may be provided with a nominal charge of RM100 per tank.*



(ii) IN TANK – 55BU & ABOVE

Kois 55 cm & above shall be entered in the participant's allotted individual tank. Judging of Kois shall be carried out and compared from their respective tanks.

CHARGES FOR KOI ENTRY (TANK)

The charges for the usage of tanks for the period of Koi Show are as follows:-

i	~5ft (1.5M) round tank	RM 900.00
ii	6.5ft (2M)round tank	RM 1,350.00

The charges for Koi entries 55BU & above shall be based on the number of tanks required. Participants are to follow the recommended stocking density to avoid fouling of water. Kois in excess of recommended numbers can be rejected at the sole discretion of the show committee. *(Kois below 55BU may be kept in the tanks but are still subject to entry charge per koi.)*

1 C) MAXIMUM NUMBERS OF KOIS PER TANK

Please adhere to the maximum number of Kois recommended per tank as follows:-



Tank Type	Koi Size	Max No of Kois
5 ft & 6.5ft Round Tank	-above 60 to 75cm	4 only
	55 – 60cm	5 only

**Should they have a combination of small and big kois, Participants shall use their good common sense and should not have more than 7 kois in their tanks to avoid fouling of water. Where in doubt, the decision of the benching team or show committee shall prevail.*

Note: Any participant who wishes to **change “name of Koi ownership”** after registration, shall be required to apply to Show Chairman before the official announcement of Koi Show winners. **An administrative charge of RM400.00 per Koi is imposed.** The change of name shall be effected after payment is made at the show ground. *(Change of ownership is not encouraged by the Club).*

- 1 E) Each participant is to ensure that the number, size and variety of Koi stipulated in the on line entry form shall be the same at benching time. The participant is to mark clearly on each Koi bag, the tank number, so that the Koi can be placed in the correct tank at the show ground as allocated by the Koi Show Committee.
- 2) **The closing date for all entries is Thurs, May 16th 2019**
- The competition is open to all and is on a first come first served basis.
 - The show committee reserves the right NOT to accept any Koi entry application submitted even though cheque has been forwarded or monies paid. Any inconvenience caused is regretted.**
- 3) Late entries may be submitted (subject to approval) after the closing date but a late entry fee of **2 times** the normal fee **will be imposed**. However, your co-operation is requested in getting the entries in as soon as possible to assist in our logistic / operations.
- 4) **PAYMENT**
All completed Entry Forms shall be submitted with a cheque made payable to **Kelab Ikan Koi ZNA Malaysia, Kuala Lumpur** or a bank in slip to MBB 014048327128 must be scanned and submitted **ON-LINE** :
- Entries without proof of bank-in-slip to Club's account will not be accepted.*
- 5) **KOI PHOTOGRAPHS**
Participants should submit photographs of their Koi **ON-LINE**. Photograph should clearly show the Koi occupying at least two-thirds of the photograph. Only blue colored tubs should be used as background. The same photographs will be printed on all Prize Winning Plaques if any.
- KOI WITHOUT PROPER PHOTOGRAPHS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COMPETITION.**
- 6) The sizes of Koi shall be stated by the Participant and is on a **self-declaration** basis. If sizing is found to be larger than declared, the Koi will be disqualified and will not be eligible for any prize award. Participants are urged to be accurate in their sizing **at benching**. The show committee may check the size of Koi during benching for judging. **Participants shall provide their own measuring tub, failing which; the show's official communal tub shall be used.**
- 7) **BENCHING**
1st Round benching for kois of all sizes will be from **3:00pm to 8:00pm on Friday, 17th May, 2019. No Koi will be accepted after 8:00pm.**
After benching, all kois regardless of size shall be placed into their respective participant's tanks. On final completion of all benching, participants may inspect their Koi in their respective tanks. Should there be any queries raised regarding the classification and size category, please notify the Benching Head, or any Show Committee members immediately.

The Show Committee reserves the right to reject and/or remove any Koi, which is found to be sick, diseased, deformed or unsuitable for the show.

Benching for Small Kois from 25BU – 50BU in PVC bags will be from **(1:00pm to 2:00pm)** on Sat, 18th May, 2019.

Participants or their handlers shall commence bagging kois in this size division in the official PVC bags within the allotted time. Participants shall stick the **Barcode sticker &** use waterproof marker pen to mark on the side of each bag clearly to identify **participant's ID number, Koi identity #, size and variety**. They should be brought to the small kois area and placed on the demarcated blue colour floor area, according to the variety and size division indicated on the floor. Kois which are not bagged up and placed properly at the designated area, shall not be judged, hence shall receive no prize.


After judging, NO Koi is to be removed or placed back into their respective tank, without the permission, verification and escort by the designated Koi show officer.

8) TANK & WATER MANAGEMENT

The show Committee will provide fresh water to participants during the show. Participants are to look after their own kois in their own tank, including the removal of faeces or dirty water and prohibited from making contacts or mixing of kois at the show ground. Participants or handlers shall not tamper with and/or add any substances into the water. The show Committee shall not be held responsible for any loss, damages or death of kois.

The participant is required to make available all the necessary equipment, particularly their own benching tub/measuring tub (marked with their tank number/s on the tub with permanent marker), and to be on hand to show their Koi to the judges when so required during judging. *(Note: The participant is not allowed in judging area during judging, unless their presence is requested by the show committee).* The participant shall use their own net for their own tank only. These benching / measuring tubs shall be removed by the participant/handler immediately after judging is completed and permitted by the Koi show committee.

The participant / handler are not permitted to discharge any water into trenches or wet the floor in the show ground. The floor must be kept dry at all time.

- 9) Participants are not allowed to remove any Koi from the display tank unless approval has been obtained from the Show Chairman. Such permission will only be given when the Koi is critically ill.
 - 10) Participants **are recommended not to feed** their Koi for **at least 7 days** prior to the show. This is to prevent pollution of the water, which may endanger the health of Kois in the display tank.
 - 11) Kois can only be removed from the display tank on **19th May, 2019** (Sunday) after **4.00 p.m.** The Show Committee will not be responsible for any Koi not collected after the specified time.
 - 12) After the judging has been completed, all prize winners may check the on-line. Should there be any error, please inform the Registration Counter Immediately.
 - 13) In the event of any dispute, the Show Committee shall be the sole authority for the Interpretation of Rules and Regulations. The judge's decision is final.

- 14) Please observe strictly the above Benching and De-benching requirements and any other ruling that may be displayed at the show ground.
- 15) The Prize Presentation for major prizes will be carried out at the show venue on Sunday 19th May. Participants are kindly requested to be properly attired when receiving prizes. All Prize Winners are requested to be present but should they be unable to attend, they may nominate another ADULT to collect the prizes on their behalf. Please note that the Show Committee cannot be held responsible for any unclaimed prizes.
All major prize winners (all the champions) are encouraged to submit the owner's personal photograph to the Koi Club within 2 weeks after the show. This is to facilitate the publication in the next show Magazine or Nichirin magazine where possible.

JUDGING PROCEDURES

JUDGES

Judges shall comprise of ZNA & SHINKOKAI Judges led by the ZNA Head Judge. Only qualified judges are allowed to vote.

GRAND CHAMPION (A) GOSANKE

Candidate will be selected from the top three(3) KoIs from 80 BU and above. The GRAND CHAMPION, 1ST RUNNER UP and the 2ND RUNNER UP are selected by secret ballot. The GRAND CHAMPION must receive a minimum of 50% +1 vote. Failing which, the 2 koIs with highest votes shall compete again. *If any of the top 3 koIs is a MALE, it shall be the MALE GRAND CHAMPION*

GRAND CHAMPION (B) NON-GOSANKE

Candidate will be selected from the top two (2) KoIs from 80 BU and above. When there is not enough suitable KoIs, judges shall select from 75 BU. The 2 best KoIs shall compete for the GRAND CHAMPION (B) , followed by the RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION B and be selected by secret ballot. *If any of the top 2 koIs is a MALE, it shall be the MALE GRAND CHAMPION*



GRAND CHAMPION (C) NON-GOSANKE

Candidate will be selected from the top two (2) KoIs from 80 BU and above. When there is not enough suitable KoIs, judges shall select from 75 BU. The 2 best KoIs shall compete for the GRAND CHAMPION (C), followed by the RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION C and be selected by secret ballot. *If any of the top 2 koIs is a MALE, it shall be the MALE GRAND CHAMPION*

JUMBO KOI (A) FOR GOSANKE / JUMBO KOI (B) , JUMBO KOI (C)

Judges shall nominate 1 koi each from 85BU & over and shall select 2 candidates from the nominees to compete for the JUMBO Prize. Emphasis shall be on size, body shape and skeletal structure. Quality and pattern is less important.

ALL CATEGORIES – KOI JUDGING

KoIs are selected for the 1st 2nd 3rd places for each variety within their respective size groupings. The selected Koi must be truly representative of the respective variety and should the Koi not meet the required standard; the judges may at their discretion, not to award any prize.

If a male is one of the top 3koIs, then it shall also be the Male 1st Prize winner. If not, Judges shall proceed to select the Male 1st from available male koIs in that category.

BEST IN SIZE (A) GOSANKE, (B) , (C) NON-GOSANKE (25 BU TO ABOVE 85 BU)

The Best-in-size for the Gosanke (Kohaku, Sanke, Showa,) for each of the above indicated size only. The best in size shall be selected from all the 1st place winners.

SUPERIOR CHAMPION (A) (B) (C)

Judges will select the best in size winner of 75 & 80 BU category to be the Superior Champion. The Head Judge will have the casting vote in case of a tie.

If the Superior Champion is a Male, then it is also awarded the MALE GRAND CHAMPION.

MATURE CHAMPION (A) (B) (C)

Judges will select one Koi from the “Best-In-Size” winners of 65BU and 70BU. The Head Judge will have casting vote in the event of a tie.

In the absence of a Male Grand Champion and the Mature Champion is a Male, then it shall be awarded the MALE GRAND CHAMPION.

ADULT CHAMPION (A) (B) (C)

Judges will select one Koi from the “Best-In-Size” winners of 55BU and 60BU. The Head Judge will have casting vote in the event of a tie.

YOUNG CHAMPION (A) (B) (C)

Judges will select one Koi from the “Best-In-Size” winners of 45BU and 50BU. The Head Judge will have casting vote in the event of a tie.

BABY CHAMPION (A) (B) (C)

Judges will select one Koi from the “Best-In-Size” winners of 35BU,40BU. The Head Judge will have casting vote in the event of a tie.

MINI BABY CHAMPION (A) (B) (C)

Judges will select one Koi from the “Best-In-Size” winners of 25BU, 30BU. The Head Judge will have casting vote in the event of a tie.

MALE KOIS

All male kois will compete in the Open category

If the Male koi win Grand Champion or Superior Champion , it automatically also win the Grand Champion Male A, B or C

GRAND CHAMPION – MALE (A) GOSANKE KOI

Candidate will be selected from MALE Gosanke Kois from 65BU onwards. The GRAND CHAMPION is selected from the 2 best Kois.

If the 1st or 2nd Runner up placing Koi in the selection of Grand Champion A is a Male koi, it shall automatically become the Grand Champion Male A.

GRAND CHAMPION – MALE (B) NON-GOSANKE KOI

Candidate will be selected from MALE Non-Gosanke Kois from 65BU onwards. The GRAND CHAMPION is selected from the 2 best Kois

GRAND CHAMPION – MALE (C) NON-GOSANKE KOI

Candidate will be selected from MALE Non-Gosanke Kois from 65BU onwards. The GRAND CHAMPION is selected from the 2 best Kois



1ST PRIZE MALE KOI

Kois are selected for the 1st place for each variety from 65BU onwards. The selected Koi must be truly representative of the respective variety and should the Koi not meet the required standard; the judges may at their discretion, not to award any prize.



SPECIAL VARIETY BEST SHUSUI

Selected from Shusui of any size



THE MOST BEAUTIFUL KOI

Each judge shall nominate 1 koi from among all the 28 Champion kois. The koi with the highest nominations shall be the winner.

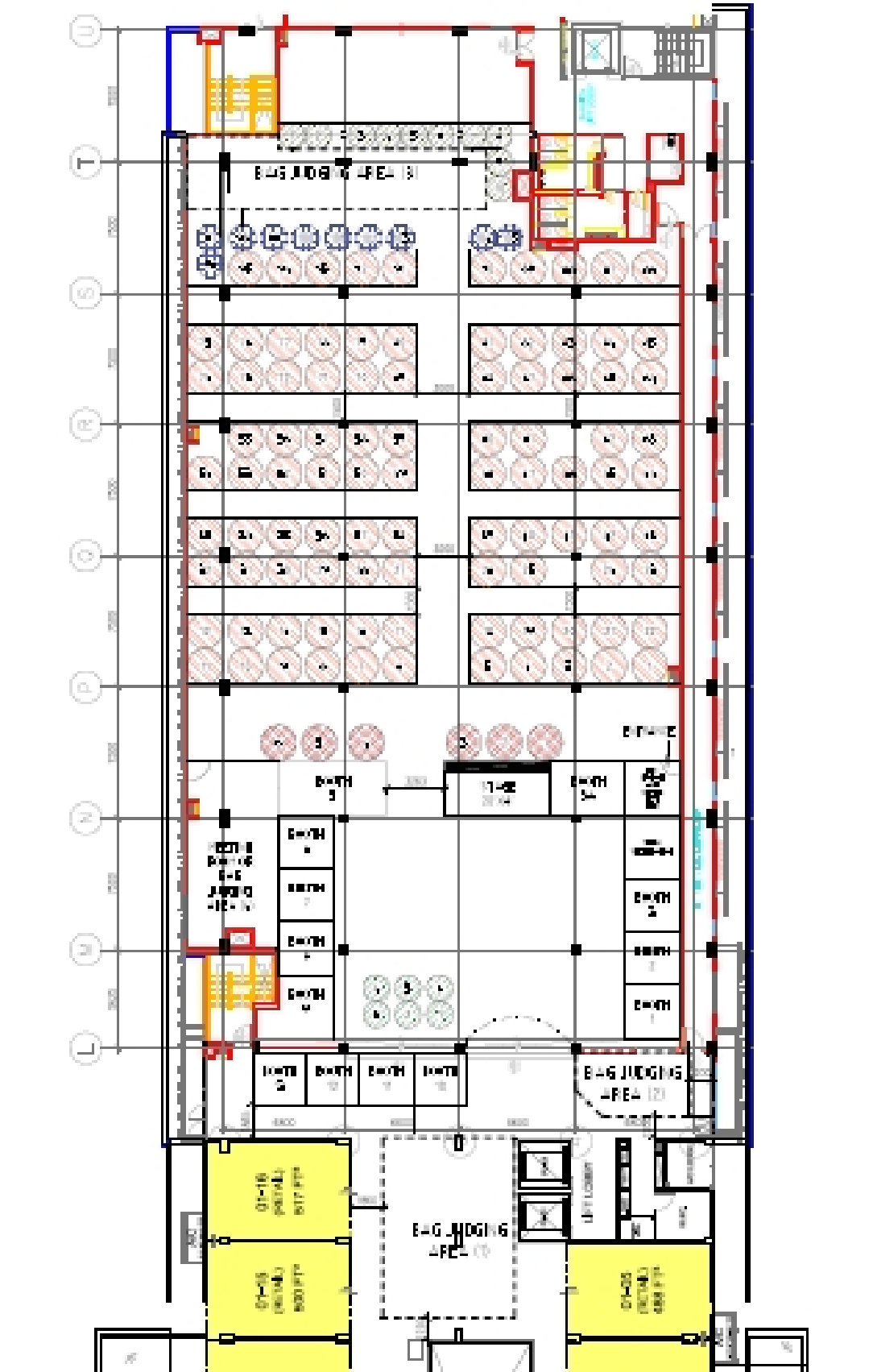

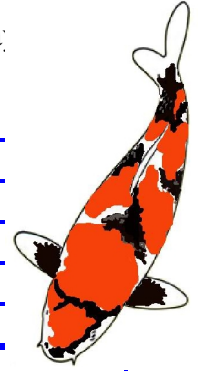
